## WRITING RATES AS PERCENTS

To write a rate as a percent, do the following steps.

1. Write the rate as a fraction.
2. Re-write the fraction as an equivalent fraction that has a denominator of 100 .
3. Use the numerator of your new fraction to make the percent.

For example, if you were given 35 out of 50 . Here is how to write it as a $\%$.
35 out of $50=\frac{35}{50}$.
50 goes into 100 twice, so I can multiply 50 by 2 to get to 100 . If I do it to the denominator, I must also do it to the numerator.

So, $\frac{35 \cdot 2}{50 \cdot 2}=\frac{70}{100}=70 \%$

Let's do another one. Say you have a rate of 18 out of 40.
18 out of $40=\frac{18}{40}$.
However, 40 does not go into 100 without a remainder. So, we need to re-write the fraction with different number that will go into 100 without a remainder. Or in other words, I must SIMPLIFY my fraction before I can make the denominator 100.

So, since 2 goes into both 18 and 40, I can do the following:
$\frac{18}{40}=\frac{18 \div 2}{40 \div 2}=\frac{9}{20} .20$ goes into 100 evenly 5 times. So multiply both 9 and 20 by 5 .
$\frac{9 \cdot 5}{20 \cdot 5}=\frac{45}{100}$. So, 18 out of $40=\frac{18}{40}=\frac{9}{20}=\frac{45}{100}=45 \%$.
